SUPPORT A TEACHER

\$40 WAGES 1 WEEK

COPE employs 15 teachers, which allows 1 teacher per class. The student/teacher ratio ranges from 47/1 to 69/1. The subjects taught are English, Kiswahili, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Christian Religious Education and Physical Education.

The average monthly wage for a teacher is \$160.

BREAKFAST & LUNCH

1 WEEK

For many of the children attending the COPE schools, what they eat at school is all they have to eat until they return to school.

COPE feeds the students breakfast and lunch every school day. Breakfast is a cup/bowl of uji which is corn flour added to boiling water until it is the texture of hot cereal. A little sugar is added.

Lunch is a cup/bowl of corn and beans. A little salt is added.

SECURITY WALL

\$30 WALL SECTION 1 FT

Every school in Kenya is required to fence their compound. Because we registered Tapadany Christian Academy as a private school, we must pay for the project ourselves. After investigation, it was decided it was best to fence for compliance and security. We bought a brick machine and began the project in 2014. It costs \$300 for each 10-foot section.

PROVIDE MEDICINE

\$15 MEDICINE 1 WEEK

Free medicine and medical care are provided to the Pokot community.

Diseases common in the area are malaria, typhoid, brucellosis, dysentery, HIV/Aids, upper respiratory infections and malnutrition. Health Education is also vitally needed.

The Dispensary was moved to the gate area so that people from the community could receive medical care without having to go through the entire compound. We have increased the budget for the Dispensary to keep up with an increase in prices for medication and an increase in the number of cases coming to the COPE Mission.

SUPPORT ANCILLARY STAFF

\$25 WAGES 1 WEEK

It takes 36 ancillary employees to keep the COPE Mission running and our students taken care of properly.

The average monthly wage of a Support Staff employee is \$100. That amount is more than the average income of people with similar educational backgrounds.
