



# Missionary Opportunity

## POSITION: Associate Mission Director

Children of Pokot Educational Fund (COPE), a non-profit organization, is looking for a couple, or individual, with hearts for Christian missions, willing to spend one or two extended periods a year in Pokot, Kenya, Africa assisting COPE in their mission of education, evangelism, and community outreach to the Pokot people. This position reports directly to the COPE Executive Director.

**MISSION OVERVIEW:** currently COPE educates and feeds around 600 students at Tapadany Christian Academy, evangelizes through worship and showing of the Jesus film in the surrounding community, runs a safe house presently supporting 43 children, supplies a dispensary to improve community health, and operates a bakery supplying jobs to local residents.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

### WHILE IN KENYA:

- \*Learn the Pokot traditions and current cultural status in order to truly serve the Pokot people
- \*Under supervision of the Executive Director, oversee general management of the COPE Mission
- \*Live on-site, at COPE Mission, amongst the Pokot people

### WHILE IN USA:

- \*Visit supporting churches, civic organizations, and individuals to provide updated information and seek additional support, including significant fundraising efforts.
- \*Creatively and actively develop new relationships with churches and civic organizations to grow COPE's donor base.
- \*Maintain daily contact with Pokot Administration and monitor income/expenses. Address all special fund requests.
- \*Be available for monthly Board meetings, mostly via conference call.

## REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- \*Must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- \*A heart for missions, and in particular, God's call to serve the COPE mission in Pokot, Kenya
- \*Be open and flexible to the daily leading of God's Holy Spirit
- \*Willingness to understand and respect the Pokot culture
- \*Ability to speak in front of groups
- \*Computer experience with Word, Excel, Publisher, Power Point
- \*Good organizational and administrative skills
- \*Ability to live in Pokot for one or two extended periods of time during the year
- \*Willing and able to live in remote area without electricity and running water
